By implementing this plan, PTZ will strengthen Poland's role in global zebrafish research while supporting members at all career stages.

Current Achievements (2015–2025)

- Organized 4 successful PTZ Meetings.
- Organized 6 workshops, the 7th underway
- · Launched outreach programs engaging the public.
- Established a Zebrafish Breeding & Welfare Section.
- Developed international ties with the European Zebrafish Society (EZS) and European Animal Research Association (EARA).
- Built a strong financial and organizational foundation.

Strategic Pillars & Action Plan

1. Research Excellence & Collaboration

2025-2026:

- Create a database of Polish zebrafish facilities (equipment, specializations, contacts).
- Launch collaborative funding programs (lab exchanges, workshops).
- Host CRISPR-Cas9 workshops.
- Establish a mentorship program (PhD and up to three years after + senior scientists).

2027-2030:

- Formalize partnerships with additional international organizations.
- Introduce PTZ-specific small research grants.

2. Education & Professional Development

2025-2026:

- Soft skills training (presentations, poster design, group managment).
- Publish Polish-language husbandry guidelines.
- Develop online educational resources.

2027-2030:

- Design undergraduate/graduate zebrafish curricula.
- Launch annual summer schools.

3. Standardization & Best Practices

2025-2026:

- Publish **husbandry/welfare guidelines** to be used for grants/ethics committees applications.
- Standardize experimental protocols.
- Form an ethics advisory committee.

2027-2030:

• Contribute to international standards (EZS).

4. Community Building & Networking

2025-2026:

- Redesign PTZ website (resource hub, member directory).
- Host quarterly online seminars ("Grant Stories").
- Strengthen brand recognition.

2027-2030:

- Create a **Polish zebrafish researcher network** (LinkedIn).
- Partner with industry/biotech companies.

5. Public Outreach & Science Communication

2025-2026:

- Develop Primary and secondary **school materials** about zebrafish.
- Boost social media presence.
- Organize open-house events at zebrafish labs.

2027-2030:

- Launch a citizen science project.
- Collaborate with science museums (e.g., Copernicus Center or similar).

- Board Review: Discuss priorities at the next meeting.
- Working Groups: Volunteers needed for committees (e.g., Guidelines, Travel Grants).
